Bequest Language

General Bequest: "I give to Just in Time for Foster Youth, a nonprofit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of California, with the Tax ID #20-5448416 and the current business address of PO Box 601627, San Diego, CA 92160, the sum of \$ (or substitute in "all of my interest in the following described property") to be used in furtherance of its exempt charitable purposes."
Residual or Proportional Bequest: Substitute in "percent or all of the residue of my estate."
Contingent bequests: can be specified if you wish to name <i>Just in Time for Foster Youth</i> as beneficiary if all other beneficiaries are deceased.
